Steps to project development

- 1. Check **relevance**
- 2. Get inspired
- 3. Share **project idea**
- 4. Find partners
- 5. Ask for **feedback** (available only when call is open)

Check relevance


Is Interreg Europe for you?







Share project idea


Publish your project idea on our website to tell others:

- ⇒ what partners you are looking for

- ⇒ ask for **programme's feedback** (one feedback per idea and call)

Key to successful application

- Thorough preparation
 - Read carefully programme documents (e.g., the manual)
- Assistance tools
 - Use self-assessment tool
 - Ask for JS feedback (during open call)
 - Join assistance events
- Get to know our selection process
 - 1. Eligibility = ineligible proposals get **no further assessment**
 - 2. Quality criteria = meet programme expectations
