Check relevance


Is Interreg Europe for you?







Share project idea


Publish your project idea on our website to tell others:

- ⇒ what you'd like to do
- ⇒ what partners you are looking for



Find partners

Search for people or organisations to find project partners

Ask for feedback from the joint secretariat

- Once the call is open and your project idea is clear
- ⇒ ask for **programme's feedback** (one feedback per idea and call)


